



Subject: Announcement to postpone CANSO Asia Pacific Safety Seminar to 17-18 July 2010

Amsterdam, 12 April 2010

Dear Conference Participant,

As you may be aware, a number of travel advisories have been issued against travel to Thailand, in view of the current political uncertainty there.

Although we are satisfied that there is no personal risk to conference delegates attending the 2nd CANSO Asia Pacific Safety Seminar in Hua Hin, there is uncertainty surrounding the effects of further demonstrations, and the possibility of disrupted travel. It is likely that the situation will be resolved in the near future, and therefore, the Asia Pacific CANSO CEO Committee (APC3) has taken the decision to postpone the Seminar to 18-20 July 2010. The APC3 believes this will maximize attendance at the Seminar and ensure a successful event for all.

In the meantime, CANSO will carefully monitor developments and keep all delegates informed of the new arrangements for the Conference, as soon as they are made.

We look forward to welcoming you to Hua Hin in July.
